BYLAW NO. 5194

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR A REFERENDUM WITHIN THE CITY OF NANAIMO

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the City of Nanaimo may, by bylaw pursuant to Section 283 of the *Municipal Act*, provide for a referendum to obtain the electors opinion on a question that affects the municipality and with which the Council has power to deal, and

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Nanaimo wishes to obtain the opinion and assent of the electors to borrow funds for the construction of a leisure and aquatic centre within the City;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Municipal Council of the City of Nanaimo, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. Title:

This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "LEISURE AND AQUATIC CENTRE REFERENDUM AUTHORIZATION BYLAW 1996 NO. 5194".

2. Referendum Question:

The following referendum question shall be put before the electorate on 1996-NOV-16 for their consideration and opinion, namely:

"Are you in favour of borrowing up to 8.6 Million Dollars as partial funding for the construction of a 52-metre pool and leisure facility in the City of Nanaimo?"
