**Everyone Welcome** – Designed for skaters of all ages and abilities. These sessions provide an excellent opportunity for all members of the community to get active! Parent & Tot (6 years & under) - An excellent opportunity to introduce children to the ice or to work on skills learned in our RecSkate lessons. Come on the ice in shoes or skates and enjoy toys and hockey equipment. Helmets are mandatory for tots. Parents must accompany children on the ice. Free admission for child.

Parent & Tot Dry Floor Play (6 years & under) - An excellent opportunity to play on the floor without the ice. Balls, lego blocks, scooter cars and more are available.

**Family Skate** - During this session, there will be an area setup with toys, as well as our regular laps skating area providing opportunities for all levels and ages. All children and teens must be accompanied on the ice by an adult. Helmets are strongly recommended.

**Adult Leisure Skate** (19+) - A great addition to your fitness routine. Enjoy skating laps or practicing your skills in the designated areas. Helmets are strongly recommended.
