Hazmat Awareness NFPA 1072

Online This course is offered as a 4-hour online course for anyone who, in the course of their work, may be faced with a hazardous materials incident. This course provides the information necessary to detect the presence of hazardous materials, collect information from the available sources, connect with the appropriate resources and agencies, and protect first responders and the public from harm.

Hazmat Operations NFPA 1072
