Businesses are also encouraged to participate in the program but will not be eligible for prizes or grants.

Funding Opportunities!

The City of Nanaimo and RDN are excited to support your community projects with available funding opportunities! Whether you are an individual or part of a group, we have resources ready to help bring your ideas to life!

City of Nanaimo

Grant funding is available to support small and creative environmental projects in the City of Nanaimo. Eligible organizations, including Acting for Climate Together participants, may apply for project funding through one of the following grants:

 Community Environmental Sustainability Project Grant

Up to \$5,000 per project funding is available to support community-based sustainability projects intended to support the Green Nanaimo policies and outcomes outlined in City Plan: Nanaimo Relmagined. A total of \$20,000 in funding will be available in 2024.

2. Community Watershed Restoration Grant

Up to \$20,000 in funding is available to support community environmental restoration projects focusing on urban stream and riparian restoration enhancement, natural environment protection, and climate change adaptation solutions for watercourses.

Climate Action Seed Funding is available to participants of the Acting for Climate Together Program for projects aligned with the goals of emission reduction, climate resilience improvement, public education, and adherence to equity and climate justice principles.

Eligible projects should also align with the principles, priorities, and actions outlined in the CATAC Final Report and/or the RDN's 2023–2026 Strategic Plan, and be located within an Electoral Area in the Regional District of Nanaimo (RDN) or demonstrate a clear connection to an Electoral Area.

Each project may qualify for seed funding up to \$1,000 per application!
