

PROCLAMATION "WORLD END POLIO DAY" OCTOBER 24, 2013

Whereas: Polio is a crippling and potentially fatal disease that still threatens children in parts

of Africa, Asia and the Middle East; and

Whereas: it is critical that individuals be vaccinated against Polio in order to avoid infection

by the Polio virus; and

Whereas: the incidence of Polio has declined throughout most of the world due to various

education and immunization programs world-wide, only Afghanistan, Nigeria, and

Pakistan as the remaining polio endemic countries in 2013; and

Whereas: Rotary International and individual Rotarians have contributed over \$1 Billion and

spearheaded collaborations with governments, the World Health Organization,

UNICEF and the Centers for Disease Control, to significantly reduce the spread of

the Polio virus; and

Whereas: Rotarians worldwide have joined together with the Bill and Melinda Gates

Foundation to educate the general public about Polio and to raise funds for its

eradication; and

Whereas: The local Rotary clubs of Nanaimo and Lantzville encourage public support to raise

funds for the Polio virus eradication in the world.

NOW THEREFORE, I, John Ruttan, Mayor of the City of Nanaimo, do hereby proclaim October 24, 2013, be known as:

"WORLD END POLIO DAY"
