WHEREAS: Lights On For Lisa, June 30, encourages everyone to leave their patio lights on in support of the day she was reported missing.


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Leonard Krog, Mayor of the City of Nanaimo, do hereby proclaim June 26, 2022 as:
